Active ingredient: Halosulfuron (sulfonylurea) 750 g/kg

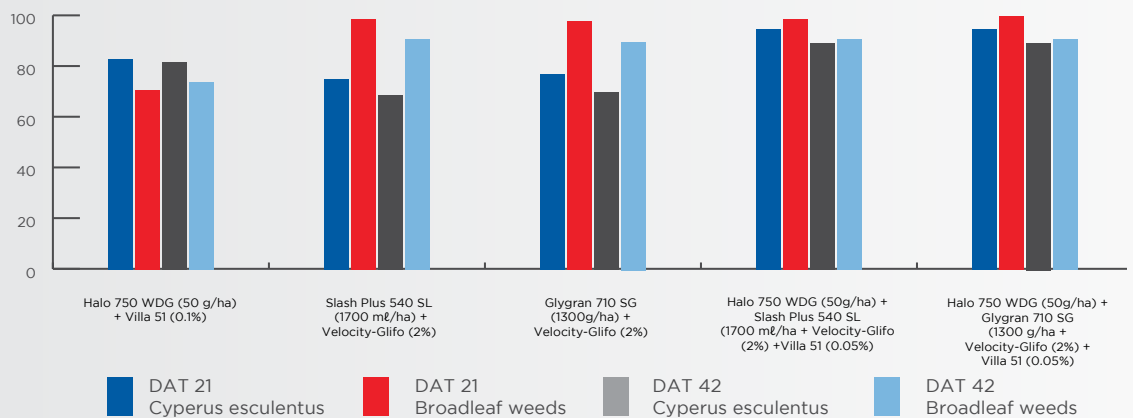
A selective water dispersible granular herbicide packed in water-soluble bags for the post-emergence control of yellow and purple nutsedge (*Cyperus spp.*) (*Cyperus esculentus*) and certain broadleaf weeds in maize



HERBICIDE



Summary of 3 trials showing the performance of HALO 750 WDG, used alone and in tank mixtures, for the control of various weeds. The graph shows the mean percentage overall broadleaf weed control (5 different weeds) as well as the mean percentage overall yellow nutsedge (*Cyperus esculentus*) control.



Features

- HALO 750 WDG is an HRAC Group B herbicide
- Systemic herbicide
- Absorbed by the roots and leaves
- Stable, high load WDG formulation
- Water-soluble bags
- Good tank mixing partner

Label recommendations

Dosage rates:

- 50 g/ha
- Refer to label for specific dosage rates with tank-mix partners

Do's and don'ts

- Apply HALO 750 WDG alone, or as a tank-mixture, 3 to 5 weeks after planting of the maize
- Apply (2) applications of HALO 750 WDG to achieve effective control of late germinating nutsedge
- Do not apply the product too early; to prevent new germination of yellow nutsedge
- Avoid late applications as the product may also give sub-optimal results
- Do not exceed the 4-leaf stage or 100 mm in height of broadleaf weeds in order to obtain optimal results
- Take care to reach under other overshadowing weeds for effective control
- For improved consistency: Add 2 % Velocity™-Super or 1 % Velocity™-Drymax & 0.05 % Villa 51 to the tank-mixture
- Do not apply as a pre-plant application in maize (waiting period 30 days)
- Do not reduce the spray solution pH by adding a buffer
