# **INFICARB 687.5 SC**

### **Features**

## Do's and Don'ts

- Start application when weather conditions favour infection, but before late blight symptoms are noticed.
- Ensure good coverage. Repeat at 7-to-10-day intervals depending on disease pressure.
- Increase the volume of water in accordance with the amount of foliage.
- Do not apply more than 6 (six) INFICARB 687.5 SC applications per growing season.
